School News

YR	We have been exploring 2D shape. We have made pictures using shapes and cards using different shapes and finding shapes in the environment. We have been really impressed with the phonics progress children have made! We have been practising our Nativity and want to thank you for the costumes! We are looking forward to performing!
Y1	We have been working hard on careful drawing and observational skills. The children have looked carefully at themselves and each other. They have drawn some fantastic self-portraits, thinking carefully about their colour choices.
Y2	This week in Y2, we have thoroughly enjoyed designing our own map for the Beebots. We used the Princess and Bear's journey as inspiration for our designs! In Maths, we have been learning about symmetry. We loved writing dialogue for the Princess, Prince and Troll Queen. We even tried to act out the final scene of the book.
Y3	We have really enjoyed finding out more about Viking life this week. We worked on our cutting skills to produce silhouettes of Viking ships and produced some great pieces of art. In Science, we have been finding out about fossils.
Y4	We have been finding the area of shapes in Maths and have spent time working on a poster to publicise a gladiator fight or chariot racing. We had to think carefully about the detail!
Y5	Year 5 have been using mind maps to plan a report about the Maya civilisation, recording everything we have learnt so far. In our Art lesson, we continued to make our face masks, painting them in harmonious and contrasting colours. We have been concentrating very hard on the intricate detail! In Science, we explored the relationship between age and height. We have welcomed Mrs Bouzidi into Y5 as our new Teaching Assistant.
