School News

YR	We have been learning about toys from the past and have compared them to those we play with now. We watched a clip about a Jack-in-the-box that made us jump! We are looking forward to our Nativity on Monday!
Y1	This week in Year 1 we have continued to learn about the Christmas story. We thought about the ways in which Christians use the Christmas story to guide their beliefs and actions. We have also started to design moon buggies which we will make next week.
Y2	Year 2 have been busy this week working on their DT project about castles. We have built a moving drawbridge. We looked at how drawbridges work and built our own out of card. We also have made a portcullis to protect our castle. The children had to problem solve and plan how to make the portcullis. They did a fantastic job.

Y5	This week, we have continued with our fractions in Maths and have written non-chronological reports on the Mayan civilisation. We have also been learning about how the Mayans thought chocolate was a gift from the gods. We made our own gift of chocolate cake, but unlike the Mayans, we didn't include chilli in it! Thank you to Mr Liggins who has been teaching 5S in Mr Smith's absence.
Y6	Year 6 have been learning about the impact of the printing press on the world. In Science, we are learning about the refraction of light.
