## School News

| YR | We have continued with our pirate theme, making wanted posters, pirate ships from junk modelling and we have been learning how to halve pirate treasure. We heard the story of David and Goliath and acted it out in class.  |
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| Y1 | This week in Y1, we have enjoyed learning about the history of castles and how they have changed over time to make a time line. In Science, the children identified different classifications of animals and sorted them into groups.  |
| Y2 | We had a fantastic day at Bedgebury this week. We worked with a Forest Ranger to play lots of games to learn about the trees they have there. We especially liked the pollination game using bubbles. We even had time to visit the adventure playground. We collected lots of cones and leaves to explore back at school, to help us remember what we learnt.   |
| Y3 | This week, Y3 thought about what they learnt in Science and whether the length of your femur affects how far you can jump. We also investigated if the tallest children crossed the playground using the fewest number of steps.   |
| Y4 | Our Ancient Greek Olympics on Monday was amazing! We took part in a variety of sports and used the shields we had made. We have also made some lovely Greek pots. In Science, we have begun to think about electricity.  |
| Y5 | Y5 have been learning about the history of St Matthew's Primary School. We toured the school looking for evidence of how the school was in the past. We examined former entrances, fireplaces, the bell tower and a memorial of former boys who died in war. We have also been practising some songs for the music concert. They are famous pieces from the 1950s like 'Rock around the Clock' and 'Tutti-Frutti.' We have learnt the chord structure- 12 bar blues.                               |
| Y6 | We are very excited, now that the stage is up in the hall! This means that we have been learning about stage directions and what they mean. We have started our transition work with Sarah from Crossways Community, ready for our move to secondary school. Our sewing skills are coming along. We can now use running stitch and back stitch. In Art, we have been working with Mr Tibbits-Williams to create a print screen, which we will use to create a poster for the backdrop to our play. |
