## School News

YR	This week, we have continued learning about the seaside. We have looked at houses by the beach and made collages of the seaside. We wrote group poems about the sea, describing what we can see, hear, smell and taste. We have also been learning our number bonds to 10.
Y1	As well as enjoying our sports day today, we have been busing adding two digit numbers and building castles in our Discovery Time. We enjoyed doing number line outside.
Y2	Year 2 have been growing cress this week in eggshells, making cress heads. We have been observing the seeds germinate and grow and have recorded our findings. We have also learnt about Eid as part of our RE work on Islam, making Eid cards. We had a fantastic morning at sports day, enjoying the events and cheering on our teams.
Y3	We have taken on the role of reporters, drafting and recording podcasts to inform Year 2 what it is like in Year 3, to prepare for September. In Maths, we have been looking at horizontal and vertical lines and in Art, we have been looking at perspective, drawing the BFG.
Y4	Our highlight was performing 'Chitty, Chitty Bang Bang' at the music concert and we did an amazing job keeping in time, playing the recorders and glockenspiels! Well done all!
Y5	Year 5 have been learning about the impact of World War II on the local area. They visited the school's air raid shelter and got a feel for what it would be like in there during a bombing raid. We have been retelling parts of the graphic novel of Tom's Midnight Garden focussing on varying our sentence starters, adding in parenthesis and developing powerful noun phrases. The children have written some wonderful pieces!
Y6	This week, Year 6 have been thinking back over their years at St Matthew's, creating a page for their leavers' book. We continue to practise our play and have been creating posters using printing, tracing and painting techniques, which will be displayed as part of the backdrop on the stage. The children have also been painting the scenery and making props. We are busy, busy, busy in Year 6!
