## Our Curriculum

### Year 6: Autumn Term 2

This newsletter is to inform you about the curriculum content for this term for your child. We hope you find this to be informative and are sure that your child will enjoy talking with you about their learning.

## English

We will continue to use the core text 'The Arrival' to write an engaging story written in the third person.

We will also use 'Can We save The Tiger' by Martin Jenkins and Vicky White to write letters, explanations, persuasive posters and poems.

## Maths

We will be following White Rose Maths including:  $\times$  and  $\div$ , fractions and decimals.

## Science

We will be leaning about Living Things – Classifying Big and Small.

We will be classifying cold and warm blooded vertebrates and invertebrates; and micro-organisms.

## Wider Curriculum

In RE, we are learning about The Gospels - 'What Would Jesus Do?'

In History, we will be learning about The Impact of War. Did WWI or WWII have the biggest impact on our locality?

In Computing, we will learning about computing systems and networks through communication and collaboration.

PSHE: We will be thinking about health and wellbeing.
