A message from Miss Harris

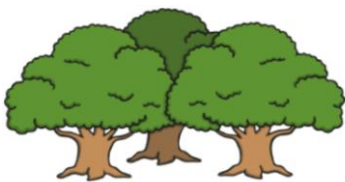

- Years R/1/2 will have their sports events in the afternoon, beginning at 1.15pm and finishing at about 2.45pm.



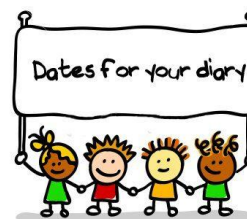
